Nummular eczema is a coin-shaped erythematous, scaly annular lesion thatis intensely pruritic and generally involves the extremities(figure-1)4

Reassuring the patient, the patient should be advised to keep their skin well moisturized and hydrated, maintain hygiene, the patient should take a balanced diet. With proper treatment, nummular eczema can be cleared over a few weeks, although the course can be chronic and characterized by relapses and remissions. Moisturizing of the skin and avoidance of identifiable aggravating factors, such as hot water baths and harsh detergents may reduce the frequency of incidents. Differential diagnosis of nummular eczema is broad as diseases that present with annular lesions may mimic nummular eczema.

- S: Septic state:
  - Septic [from absorption or pus or other deleterious substances] fever, rapid loss of strength, sinking pulse, delirium and fainting (Pyr.). [Allen]
- E: Erysipelas:
- Erysipelas when Ars. or Anth. fail to >. [Allen]
- P: Pustules Malignant:
  - Malignant pustule; black or blue blisters; often fatal in twenty-four or forty-eight hours (Lach., Pyr.). [Allen]
